Dialogic Mutual Flourishing and the Health Care System

Matthew T. Lee, PhD

Drawing on insights from the Global Flourishing Study and five years of hosting cross-cultural dialogues about flourishing (complete wellbeing), this talk offers an inspiring vision of flourishing that might serve as a 'North Star' for health care systems. Empirical measures and dialogue-based systems change processes will also be discussed.



Matthew T. Lee, Ph.D., is Professor of the Social Sciences and Humanities at Baylor University and Director of the Flourishing Network at the Human Flourishing Program at Harvard University. In addition to his roles at Baylor and Harvard, Lee is a member of the Global Flourishing Study research team, a Distinguished Visiting Scholar of Health, Flourishing, and Positive Psychology at Stony Brook University's Center for Medical Humanities, Compassionate Care, and Bioethics, a Visiting Scholar at the Benson-Henry Institute for Mind Body Medicine at Massachusetts General Hospital, and a Senior Fellow at the Center for Humanistic Management at the Gabelli School of Business at Fordham University. His latest research focuses on flourishing, benevolent service, and leadership. His book "Leadership for Flourishing" will be published in 2025 by Oxford University Press.
