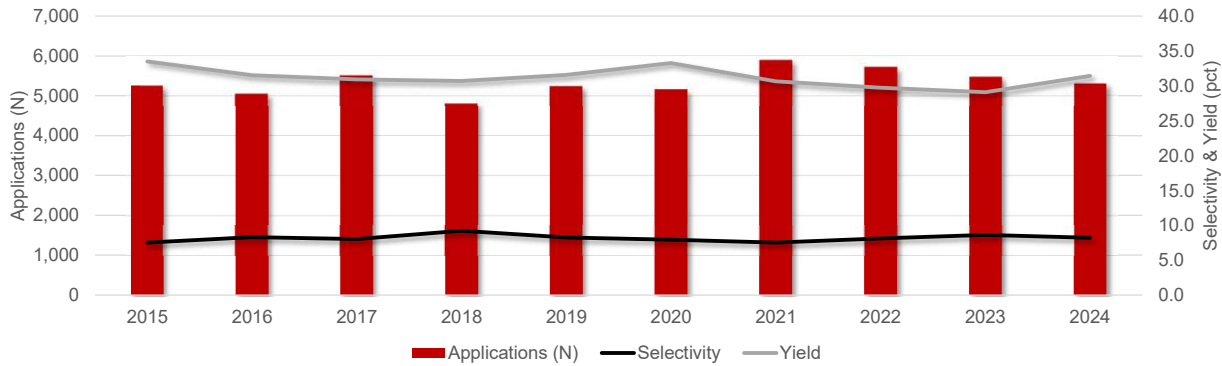

Applicants who took the old MCAT exam prior to January 20 13 will have MCAT results for this fourth section, reported on an alphabetic scale that ranges from J (low) to T (high)."
