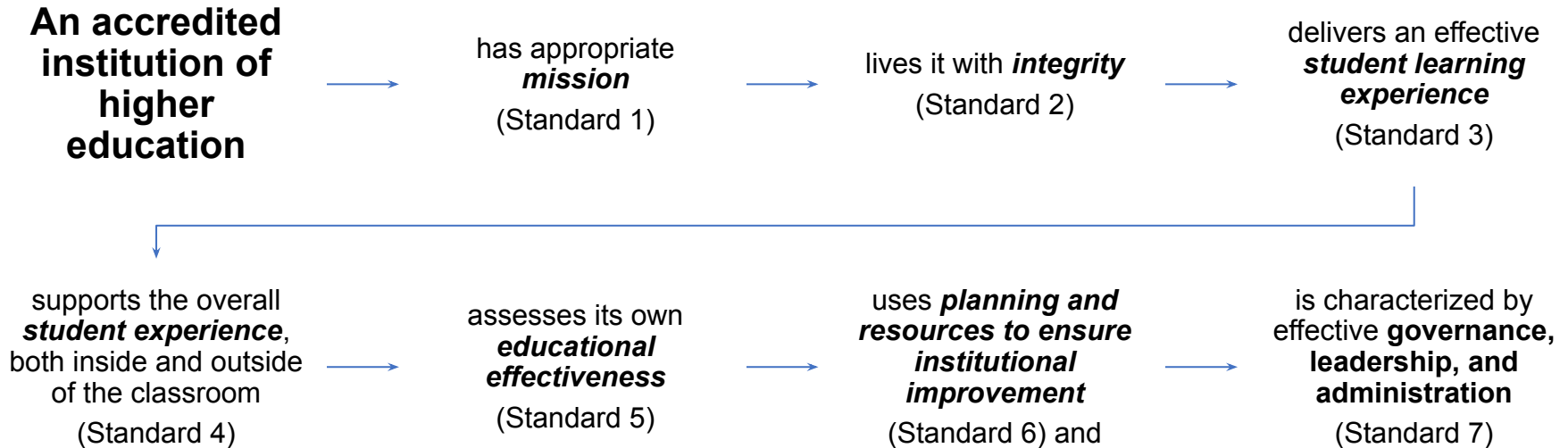

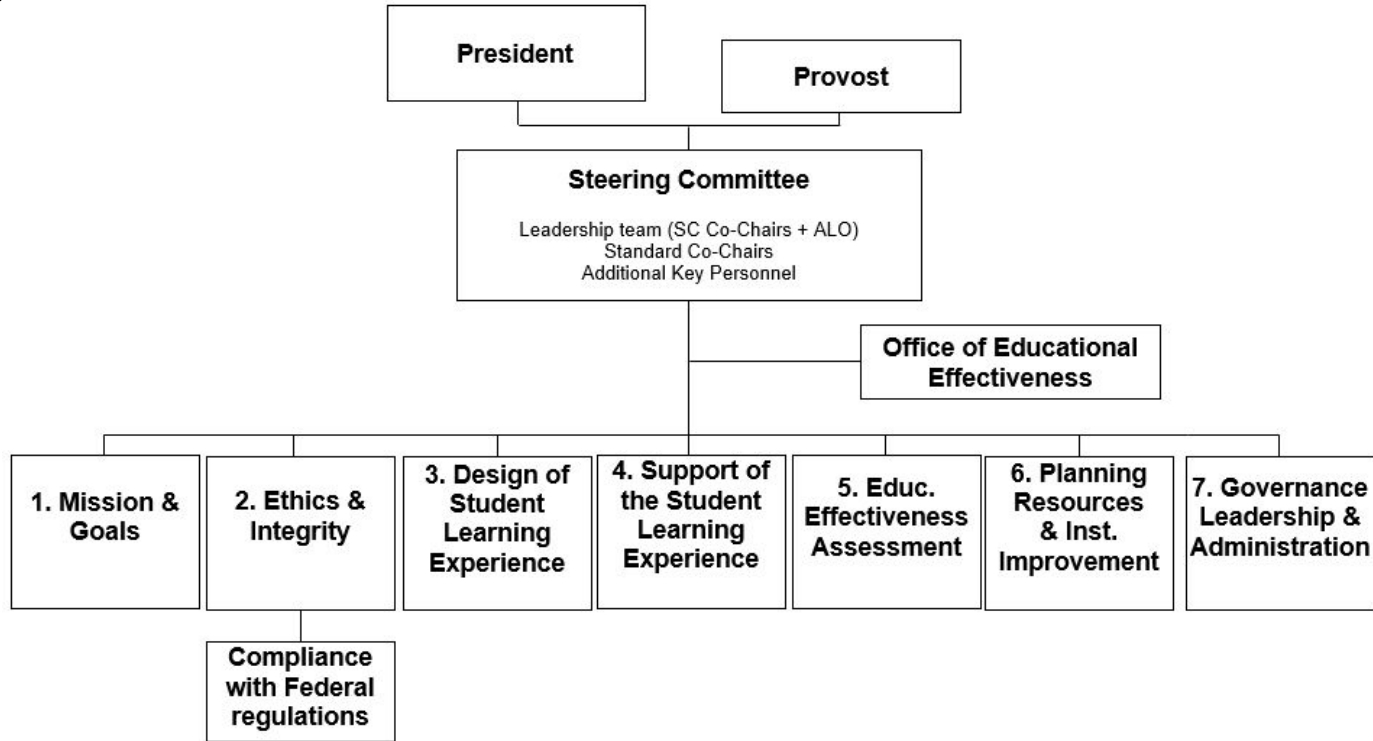


Organizational Structure
